License-compliant delivery of products that contain open-source software

Motivation

Product vendors that include open-source software in their products need to fulfill the obligations put upon them by the licenses of the open-source software code they are using. Otherwise, an immediate sales and distribution stop could be enforced.

This seminar provides a comprehensive introduction to license-compliant delivery (“distribution”) of products that contain open-source software. It provides an integrative perspective that shows how the legal counsel, the engineering department, and the person or office tasked with managing open source work together best. It is therefore suitable for all main stakeholders.
